General Statistics




Total Casualties Since Mid-March 2011

Since mid-March 2011 up until the end of **March 2022** the Violations Documentation Center documented a total of **238,869** battle-related deaths.

● **145,029 (60.71%)**
among them were Civilians


● **93,840 (39.29%)**
were Non-Civilians






Deaths by the Parties Responsible


Battle-Related Deaths

During of **March 2022**, a total number of **126** deaths were documented across different Syrian governorates, among them, **115** were documented by full name and **11** were registered as unknown.




Deaths by the Parties Responsible During of March 2022

The parties responsible for civilian casualties during of **March 2022**:







Deaths by Governorate


The largest number of documented deaths took place in Daraa with **43** deaths, followed by Homs with **18** deaths and Deir Ezzor with **16** deaths.

49 deaths were documented in other governorates.



Deaths by Category: Civilian and Non-Civilian


The number of civilian deaths reached **73** while the number of non-civilian deaths was **53**





Causes of Death

80 deaths were caused by firearms and snipers, 6 deaths by aerial attacks and barrel bombs, and 2 battle-related deaths were caused by tanks, cannons and mortars. 1 deaths were caused by torture in Syrian government detention centers, 24 deaths were caused by land mines and car explosives and 5 death resulted from torture by kidnappers, 8 from Other Reasons, 0 deaths were caused by lack of medical aid and relief in besieged areas and 0 case was caused by chlorine gas.



Deaths by Gender

The total number of adult (over 18 years of age) male deaths is **113** while the total number of adult female deaths is **1**.

The total for child battle-related deaths is **12**, with **9** for male children and **3** for female children.
