


Total Casualties Since Mid-March 2011

Since mid-March 2011 up until **Febraury 2025**, the Violations Documentation Center documented a total of **243,534** conflict-related deaths.

● **147740 (60.67%)** Among them were Civilians

• 95794 (39.33%) Were Non-Civilians








Deaths by the Parties Responsible


The parties responsible for the total number of deaths (civilian and non-civilian) from mid-March 2011 up until **Februry 2025**:

Battle-Related Deaths

During the month of **Febraury 2025**, a total number of **147** deaths were documented across different Syrian governorates; all of them were documented by their full names.






Deaths by Governorate

The largest number of documented deaths took place in **Aleppo** with **48** deaths, followed by **Deir ez-Zur** with **24** deaths and **Hama** with **17** deaths.


58 deaths were documented in other governorates.

The number of civilian deaths reached 131 while the number of non-civilian deaths was 16








Causes of Death

The number of people killed due to direct gunfire and sniping reached 52. Aerial bombardment caused the death of 13 individuals, while the number of those killed as a result of mortar shelling, artillery fire, and tank shelling amounted to 5.

Additionally, 62 people were killed due to war remnants and landmines. Finally, the center documented the deaths of 15 individuals due to other causes.






Deaths by Gender

The total number of adult (over 18 years of age) male deaths is **110** while the total number of adult female deaths is **22**.

The total for child conflict-related deaths is **15**, with **12** for male children and **13** for female children.







All figures and statistics presented in this report were retrieved from the database of the Violations Documentation Center (VDC). They are not final and are subject to continuous and periodic scrutiny by the VDC's database administrators and the field documentation team. Figures differ between reports and the most recent report is considered to be the most accurate.
